Black History Month: At the crossroads of freedom and equality

WASHINGTON (Feb. 5, 2013) – During African American/Black History Month, the nation honors the many contributions made by African Americans. This year, the Army will commemorate two important events that changed the course of history.

On Jan. 1, 1863, the Emancipation Proclamation set the United States on the path of ending slavery. A century later, on August 28, 1963, hundreds of thousands of Americans of every creed, color and background, marched on Washington, DC in the continuing pursuit of equality.
