Contractor shall invoice per schedule below:

Invoicing Instructions:

a. Invoice submittal documentation. Supporting documentation to invoice shall include a detailed list of labor hours used during the billing period. Labor categories shall be broken down by employee name, labor category, number of hours billed and hourly rate that is fully burdened plus profit. Contractor shall substantiate invoicing by evidence of actual payments such as daily time cards or by job order as normally generated in the course of the work.

Reimbursement requests for other direct costs, travel, per diem and supporting documentation shall itemize the travel by date, location, duration, unit cost, quantity and supporting documentation of reimbursable items. Documentation shall fully support the amount claimed for payment.

b. The **contractor** shall submit one “copy” of invoice vouchers, SF 1034, Public Voucher for Purchases and Services, to the primary task order monitor identified in the performance Work Statement. The contractor shall submit “*original*” and one copy to the Contracting Officer identified below. Contractor is authorized to submit partial payment. Invoice may be submitted no more often than each two week period.

c. The **task order monitor** may retain the “copy” invoice and will review and approve the vouchers (SF 1034) using the form at attachment 10a to the LOGJAMSS Ordering Guide. Vouchers (SF 1034) will then be sent to the Administrative contracting Officer at the address below. The Contracting Officer will certify SF 1034 for payment within the allowable timeframe established in the Prompt Payment Act as amended and submit to the designed paying office listed in the task order
