

FORSCOM Regulation 385-1, Forces Command Safety Policy, dated 31 March 1998, is changed as follows:

Add new paragraph. Para 5-7d. Head protection (kevlar helmet, **CVC or flight helmet as appropriate**) will be worn by all personnel operating or riding as a passenger in Army tactical vehicles **in the field**. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Commanding General, U.S. Army Forces Command.

Replace: **CVC or flight helmet as appropriate**

With: **or CVC as appropriate**

Replace: **in the field**

With: **whenever they are driven outside the motor maintenance facility. This head protection requirement applies to all FORSCOM units, regardless of their installation of assignment or deployment status.**
