History. This is a revision of FORSCOM Pamphlet 25-30, dated 1 Oct 95.

Summary. This Pamphlet provides a current list of all FORSCOM command publications and blank forms.

Chapter 1 is also used to establish/change initial distribution requirements for FORSCOM publications.

Applicability. This Pamphlet applies to the Active Army, the Army National Guard, and the United States Army Reserve.

Suggested improvements. The proponent agency of this Pamphlet is Deputy Chief of Staff for Command, Control, Communications and Computers (DCSC4), FORSCOM. Section I

Introduction

1-1. General

This Pamphlet is a consolidated index of current FORSCOM publications and blank forms.

1-2. New material

A plus sign (+) appearing after the publication number indicates new or revised material. UR means the publication is under revision but has not been published. Underlined means publication is linked and available for download from the Internet at: <http://www.forscom.army.mil>.

1-3. Joint proponent publications

On joint proponent publications, the name of the other proponent is shown in parentheses after the title of the publication.

1-4. Distribution information for publications

The code shown in the distribution column reflects the level of distribution under the previous distribution scheme. Future publications will reflect the distribution scheme below.

a. Distribution codes used for FORSCOM publications are as follows:

(1) Level A - Applicable to company or similar organizational units.

(2) Level B - Applicable to brigade, regiment, group, battle group, and battalion level.

(3) Level C - Applicable to installations or similar activities including headquarters of divisions and comparable commands.

(4) Level D - Applicable to MACOMs, CONUSA, and TAGs.

(5) Level E - Applicable to FORSCOM headquarters.

b. Codes used to indicate classified publications are:

(O) For official use only

(U) Title of publication is unclassified

(C) Confidential

(S) Secret

1-5. Separation of Index and Subscription Form

To reduce workload on units, activities, and installations, FORSCOM Form 12-1-R (prescribed by FORSCOM Supplement 1 to AR 25-30) has been separated from the FORSCOM Publications Index (See Figure 1-1 for sample). Copies of FORSCOM Form 12-1-R and FORSCOM Supplement 1 to AR 25-30 are available over the Internet at:

Update FORSCOM subscription requirements (when applicable) by submitting a copy of the FORSCOM Form 12-1-R, FORSCOM Publications Subscription Sheet, through proper channels (See Table 1-1). (See FORSCOM Supplement 1 to AR 25-30 for guidance on who is authorized an account.) Keep a copy of the Subscription Form for future reference. Review your account and submit changes as needed.

RESUPPLY: We no longer issue resupply of FORSCOM publications. After initial distribution, reproduction of additional copies is a user's responsibility. The Fort Gillem Publications Stockroom for miscellaneous/special requests will

maintain a limited supply, but only one copy will be issued as a print master. ***Stockroom Managers are expected to keep master copies on file for local reproduction requests.*** The Fort Gillem Publications Stockroom will continue to issue resupply to activities serviced by the Defense Printing, Fort McPherson Branch Office.

Chapter 2

Forms

Section I

Introduction

2-1. General

This section contains a list of FORSCOM blank forms, posters, and charts.

a. Commanders of CONUSA, USARC, FORSCOM/ TRADOC installations, State Adjutants General, and FORSCOM units and activities reporting directly to HQ FORSCOM are authorized to requisition needed forms (less "R" type forms) directly from the Publications Stockroom, Fort Gillem, Forest Park, Georgia 30297.

b. Commanders of units and activities subordinate to the above must submit their requisitions (using DA Form 17) to the appropriate CONUSA, USARC, installation, or State Adjutant General, in accordance with instructions issued by the commanders concerned.

2-2. Local reproduction

Forms identified with an "R" after the numbers are authorized for local reproduction by using organizations, units, and activities. Locally automated "R" forms will carry the current form number and date as assigned by this headquarters and -E denoting electronic generation, with structure and size remaining the same as blank form, if at all possible. FORSCOM "R" forms, automated by your headquarters, will not be changed, nor will any information be added without permission of proponent. The automated form will be approved, and a copy retained by the local forms management office. Forms further identified with an asterisk (*) after the "R" are stocked in the Publications Stockroom at Fort Gillem for resupply to the commanders listed in paragraph 2-1a, above, who cannot

2-3. Supply of forms

When a FORSCOM form is designed for local reproduction ("R" forms), camera-ready copies will be provided to Forms Management Officers at CONUSA, USARC, FORSCOM/ TRADOC installations, and State Adjutants General, as appropriate. In the interest of economy only those forms required as a filled in sample will be shown in the prescribing directive. If the "R" form in the prescribing directive is beyond the unit's (user) reproduction capability, a requisition (DA Form 17) should be submitted to the appropriate commander indicated in paragraph 2-1b, above. Stocked forms are ordered by the local publications stockroom from the stockroom at Fort Gillem for all users on their installation. USAR/ARNG units not located on a FORSCOM installation will order forms through their appropriate USARC/State Adjutant General. AC FORSCOM units on non-FORSCOM installations will order stocked forms from the stockroom at Fort Gillem using their account number.

Section VI

3.1 Defining Publications

Command publications have only command application. They apply only to the issuing command and have no application to other commands in the Army or to elements in other departments or Government agencies. FORSCOM policies and procedures for establishing FORSCOM publications are found in FORSCOM Memorandum 1-11, Staff Administrative Procedures. Definitions are provided below:

Supplements

Command supplements contain policies, responsibilities, and administrative procedures required to implement Army Regulations (AR). It is the only medium authorized to provide subordinate commanders additional instructions to implement an AR. Supplements do not supersede, change, or rescind any portion of an Army Regulation. When a new AR comes out, the previous FORSCOM Supplement becomes rescinded.

Regulations

Command regulations contain policies, responsibilities, and administrative procedures relating to subjects not contained in Army Regulations. They are permanent directives, effective until superseded or rescinded. Each regulation is confined to a single subject and is the only authority to prescribe mandatory use of command forms.

Pamphlets

Command pamphlets are permanent instructional or informational publications that apply command-wide. Pamphlets are not directive. They provide guidance and information needed to carry out policies and procedures established by regulations. Forms established by pamphlets are for optional use only.

Memorandums

Command memorandums apply to HQ FORSCOM only. They establish policies, responsibilities, and administrative procedures; pattern of organizations and workflow; and recurring and special forms and reports within HQ FORSCOM. They are effective until superseded or rescinded.

Circulars

Command circulars contain material that is directive or informational, is transitory, or needs to be published only once. Circulars expire 2 years from the date of issue or earlier.
