Page 2, paragraph 4g(2). Add subparagraph (f).

(f) Within FORSCOM approving official for travel within CONUS is delegated to Commanders, First, Third, and Fifth United States Armies; Commanders, I Corps, III Corps; XVIII Airborne Corps; Commander, United States Army Signal Command; Commander, United States Army Reserve Command; Commanders, Major United States Army Reserve Commands; and Installation Commanders in the grade of Colonel or higher.
