Page 2, paragraph 2-5, Authority to approve cash awards. Add subparagraph d and subparagraph e.

- d. Cash awards up to and including \$10,000 may be approved by the following:
 - (1) CONUSA, corps, division and installation commanders.
 - (2) HQ FORSCOM staff agency chiefs.

e. Nominations for awards in excess of \$10,000 must be forwarded through the servicing Civilian Personnel Office to HQ FORSCOM, ATTN: AFPI-CP, 1777 Hardee Avenue, SW., Fort McPherson, GA 30330-1062. Nominations must document that the employee meets all criteria for the award.

Page 12, paragraph 9-3, Outstanding Civilian Service Award. Add subparagraph c.

- c. Authority to approve and present this award is delegated to Commanders, Major General and above.
