

**Information Management
Forces Command (FORSCOM) Office Symbols**

History. This is the second publication of this regulation.

Summary. This regulation establishes office symbols, IAW AR 25-1, for Headquarters, Forces Command (HQ FORSCOM) and major subordinate commands and tactical units assigned to FORSCOM.

Applicability. This regulation applies to all Active Army and US Army Reserve elements under command and control of HQ FORSCOM.

Supplementation. Commanders will not supplement this regulation without prior approval from Commander, HQ FORSCOM, Deputy Chief of Staff, G-6 (AFCI-PR), 1777 Hardee Avenue SW, Fort McPherson, GA 30330-1062.

Changes. Local changes to this regulation are not authorized unless authenticated by the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-6 (DCS, G-6).

Suggested improvements. The DCS, G-6, HQ FORSCOM, is the proponent of this regulation. FORSCOM Regulation 25-50

1. Purpose

This regulation describes the process and procedures necessary to change mailing addresses and office symbols for units/activities under the command and control of HQ FORSCOM.

3. General Information

- a. The March 1997 version of AR 25-1 rescinded AR 340-9, Office Symbols, 12 August 1985 and all supplements thereto.
- b. This regulation is intended to provide official office symbols for units/activities under the command and control of HQ FORSCOM IAW AR 25-1.
- c. Department of Army Pamphlet 25-50, 3 September 2002, replaced tables 1 through 41 with a link to the electronic version of Army addresses located at www.rmda.belvoir.army.mil/armyaddress. Units/activities under the command and control of HQ FORSCOM should at a minimum annually, or as changes occur, review and update their addresses and office symbols on the above web site. Information on this web site will be used as official mailing addresses.
- d. Request to add, change or delete office symbols should be submitted via memorandum to Commander, HQ FORSCOM, DCS, G-6 (AFCI-PR), 1777 Hardee Avenue SW, Fort McPherson, GA 30330-1062.
