Supplementation. Supplementation of this regulation is prohibited without prior approval from the Commander, PERSCOM (TAPC-PEC), Alexandria, VA 22331-0481.

FOR THE COMMANDER:

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AR 600-8-1, dated 20 October 1994, is supplemented as follows:

Page 6, paragraph 2-16. Add subparagraph d.

d. The serious illness or death of any key or senior FORSCOM personnel will be reported immediately by telephone to the Office of the Secretary General Staff, HQ FORSCOM, during duty hours or to the FORSCOM Operations Center during non-duty hours (RCS exempt, para 7-2h, AR 335-15). Casualty area commanders/installation commanders will establish procedures to ensure that

information on all general officers, including ARNG and USAR and active duty commanders and chiefs of staff in the grade of colonel is reported. No format is prescribed for this report. The caller should provide as much information as possible, to include the name and address of the next-of-kin (NOK) and whether NOK has been advised of the situation. If a commander is involved, the report will state who is in temporary command. The lack of complete information should not delay an initial report.
